



Boba Fett Pillow



Let's make a Boba Fett Pillow, just in time for Star Wars day! My pattern makes a small pillow, more the size of a plushie toy. The pillow is made from felt. For a really nice pillow you can splurge for the fancy wool stuff. But if you're like me, A couple \$0.25 sheet from the craft store will do the trick. The pillow can be totally constructed with a sewing machine (lazy sewists rejoice!) but of course you can hand sew if you prefer. Let's get started!

Supplies:

- 2 sheets green felt
- 1 sheet red felt
- 1 sheet yellow felt
- 1 sheet black felt
- coordinating thread
- stuffing



1. Start by printing and cutting out the pattern pieces.
2. Trace the pattern pieces onto the felt and cut out the shapes.



3. Place the black piece on top of one of the green pieces like this. Use black thread to sew the black piece down, staying close to the edges (1/8" tops).



4. Now line up the yellow pieces like this. Use yellow thread to sew them in place, again staying very close to the edges.



5. Line up the red piece like this and use red thread to sew it in place. (I was too lazy to change my bobbin for all these steps, so I had a green bobbin in the whole time)



6. Now place this piece on top of the other green piece (wrong sides together) and pin them together. Sew around the the outside edges with a narrow seam allowance (about 1/8" or less), leaving an opening for turning. I left my opening along the bottom



7. Now stuff the pillow. I used polyfill for this one, but I've also used fabric scraps to stuff projects like this which makes a stiffer pillow. Then pin the opening closed and sew along the edge.



All done!

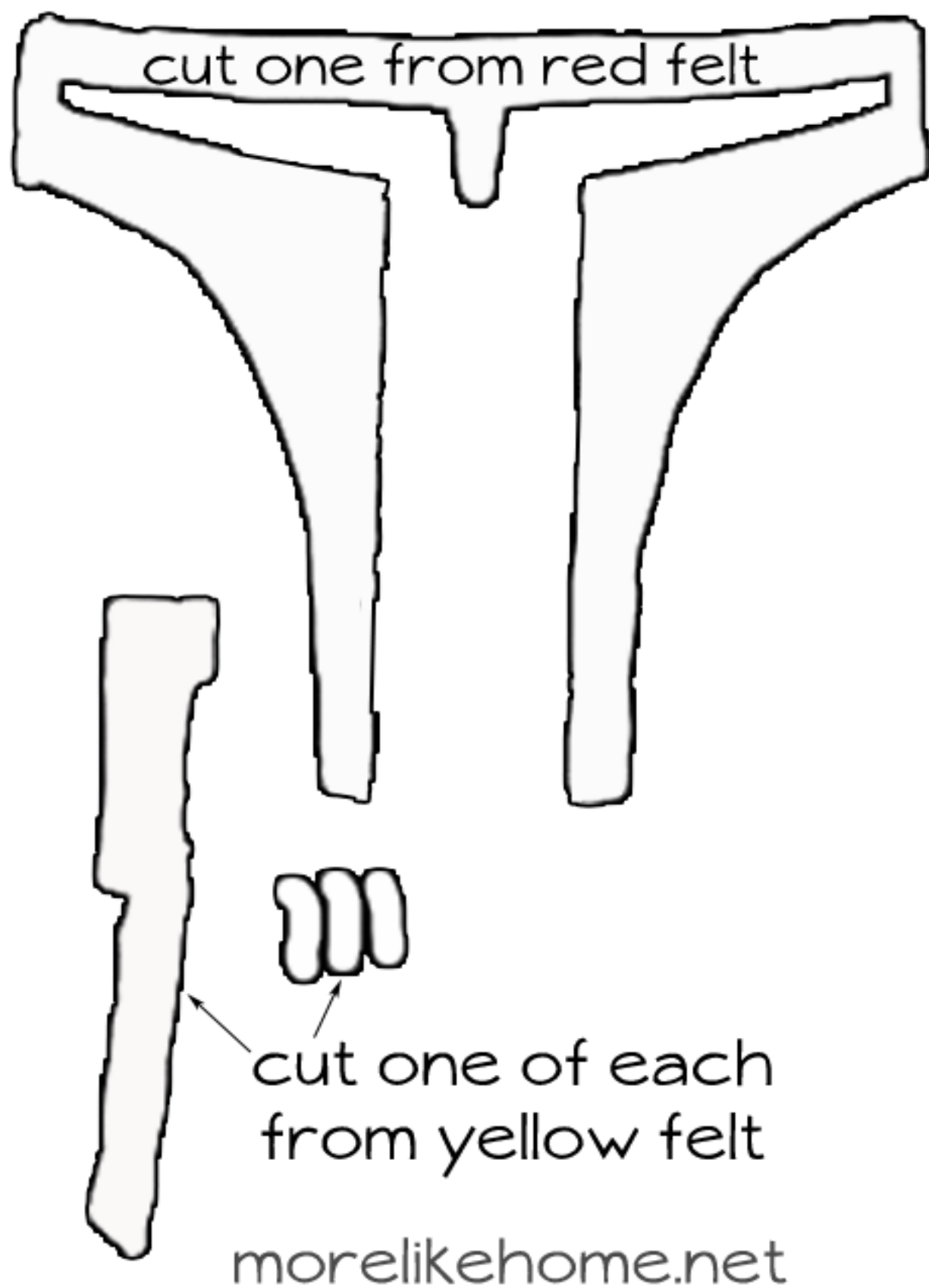
