

- Directions:*
1. Cut out fabric pieces.
 2. Pin pieces with right sides together.
 3. Sew around outside edges with 1/4" seam allowance, leaving a 2-3" opening at the bottom of the bib.
 4. Clip the curves.
 5. Turn right side out and tuck in seam allowance at the opening.
 6. Top stitch around the edge of the bib, being sure to catch all the layers and close up the opening.
 7. Add a snap or velcro to the bib tabs.

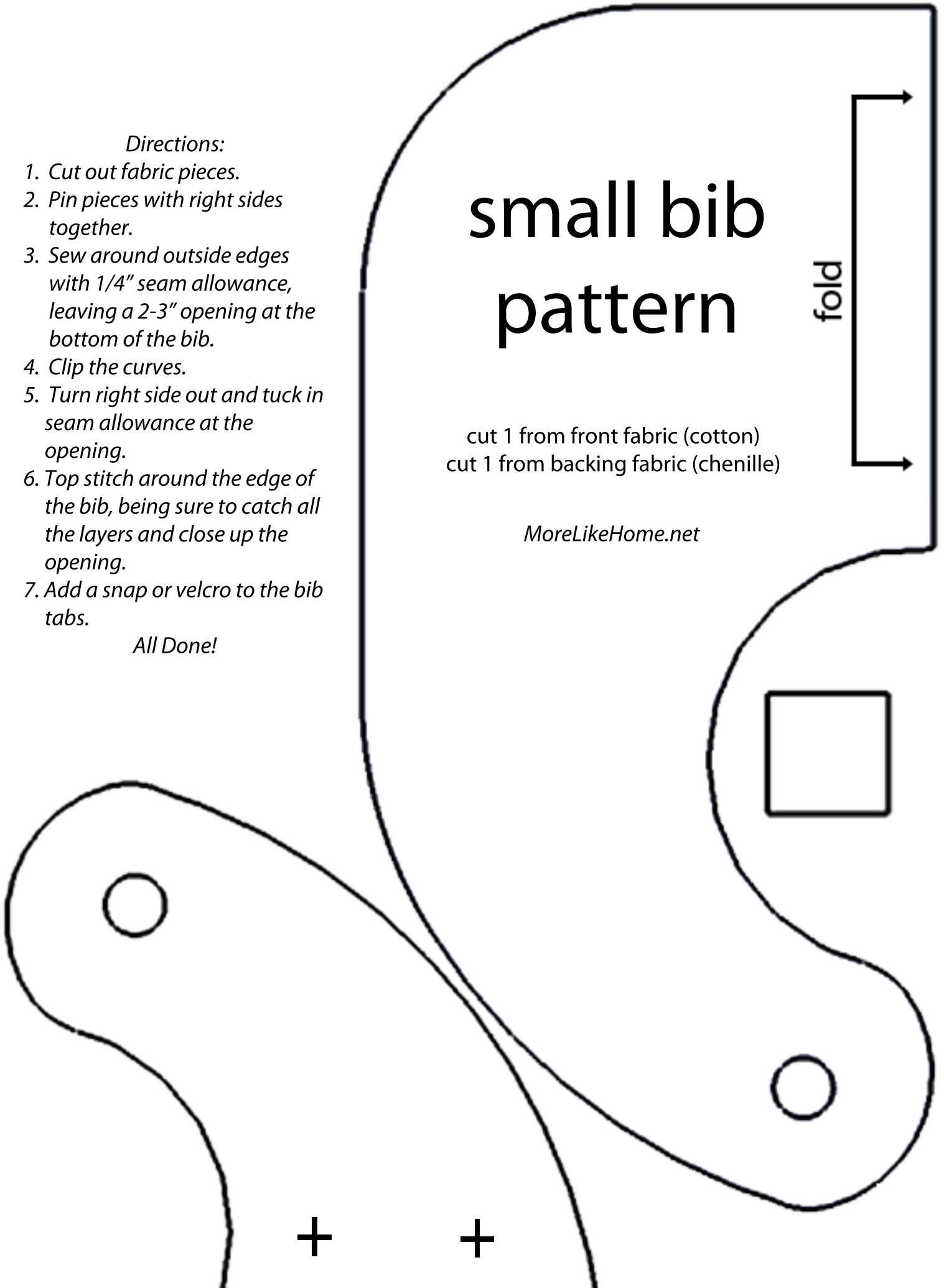
